



25 Years – Proof of purchase required.
Warranty is invalid if evidence of abuse, misuse or chemical attack

#### Cleaning & care guidelines

- 1. After use, rinse the surface with water and wipe with a damp cloth, chamois or sponge.
- 2. Remove light marks with a mild household detergent or mild all-purpose cleaner; soak heavier marks for around 15–20 minutes before cleaning.
- 3. Calcium deposits may be avoided by ensuring that all fittings are properly sealed and that all water is removed after use. Any calcium deposits that do occur can be removed with a hand-hot 1:1 solution of vinegar and water (do not use concentrated vinegar). After cleaning, rinse the surface thoroughly.
- 4. When using a drain cleaning product, please read the manufacturer's instructions carefully and pour the cleaner directly into the wastepipe. Immediately remove any cleaner that may have splashed onto the enamel.

Do not use coarse, abrasive powder cleaners, highly acidic or solvent-based cleaning agents, aggressive acids and lyes (e.g. caustic soda, vinegar essences, alkaline chlorine-based cleaning agents) abrasive cleaning sponges/cloths, coloured cleaning agents.
